Cultural Day - 23 September 2021

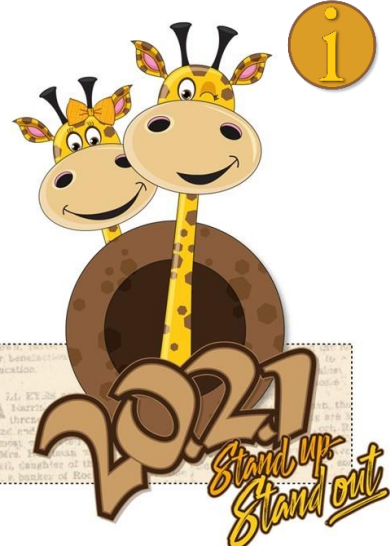

Rhino Tag and Release

Olivia, Stephanie Darley and their family were privileged to be invited on a rhino tag and release. This was the first time that children have been allowed on a game capture of this nature. The girls were briefed by a vet. They got to see first-hand what goes right and what to do when things go wrong. They got to see how hard the teams must work on the ground and in the air. They learnt how to handle an animal of that size, notching and its meaning, why the animal gets vitamins, its eyes covered, ear plugs and where to place the intravenous needle and why. They also learnt how to wake the animal up, which is the most important part of the capture. Well done girls! We are so glad to see that you made the most of this once in a lifetime opportunity!

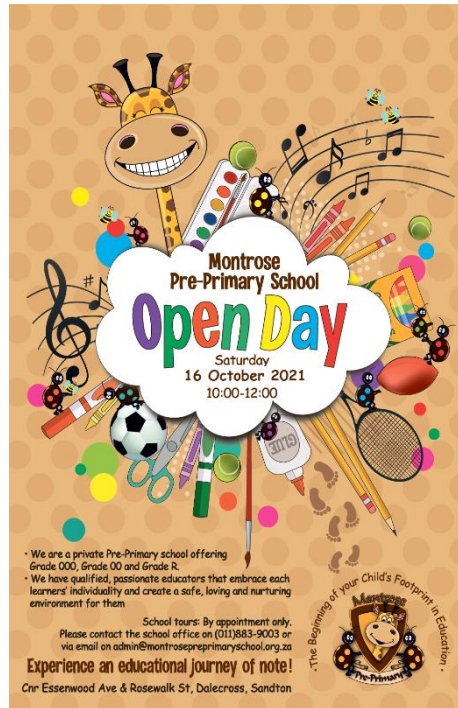
