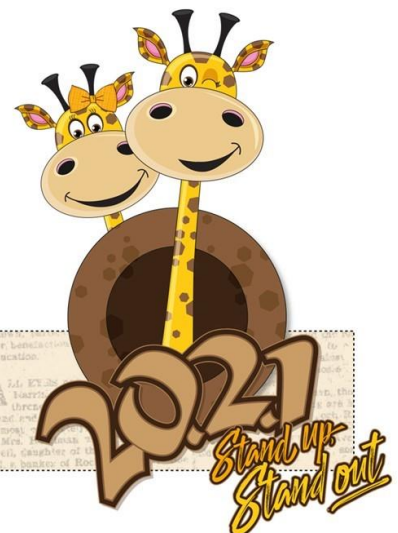
Sandton Rotary Poetry Competition Recital
